An entry-level qualification is an internship in a company that is subject to social insurance contributions and lasts 6 to 12 months. You will receive a salary and travel expenses. The chances of being taken on are very good.

Entry qualifications are possible in many training occupations in the dual system. Information is available from the employment agency, the chambers of industry and commerce and the chambers of skilled trades.
